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<sup>1</sup> **Homeostasis** is an organism's ability to maintain its internal balance. The term originates from the Greek words *homeo* (similar, same) and *stasis* (state, balance), meaning "maintaining a steady state" or "remaining stable."

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In biological terms, homeostasis describes the process by which a living organism maintains its internal equilibrium. Many vital parameters, such as body temperature, blood sugar levels, fluid-electrolyte balance, and blood pressure, are kept within a stable, regulated range through this process, regardless of external environmental fluctuations.

**Examples of Homeostasis:**

- The human body maintains an average body temperature within a narrow range. For instance, if the body overheats, mechanisms such as sweating occur to cool it down; conversely, when it's cold, the body generates heat through muscle shivering.
- Regulation of blood sugar is another example of a homeostatic mechanism. After eating, insulin is released to lower elevated blood sugar levels, whereas during extended fasting, the hormone glucagon raises blood sugar levels to prevent hypoglycemia.
- The functioning of the kidneys plays a critical role in water balance. Kidneys can concentrate or dilute urine as needed, maintaining the body's fluid and electrolyte equilibrium, demonstrating another essential homeostatic mechanism.

All the organs and systems of the body collaboratively work to maintain this precise internal balance, continuously cooperating to preserve the stability essential for life.

<sup>2</sup> A miracle is not an "infringement" upon the laws God established in nature; rather, it demonstrates how God controls these laws and, when He wills, manifests them in an alternative manner.

Science examines observable and repeatable events governed by natural laws. Miracles, on the other hand, cannot be scientifically explained because they occur outside the regular functioning of natural laws. However, this does not mean miracles "violate" those laws. Instead, miracles reflect the Creator's purposeful intervention in the workings of nature. For instance, the lack of a scientific explanation for a miracle does not imply that the event is "irrational"; rather, it indicates a source beyond the current understanding of natural laws.

From a logical perspective, if natural laws represent an order established by a Creator, it is entirely coherent for that Creator to intervene in or alter this order. Miracles are simply reflections of such interventions. This firmly grounds the concept of miracles in logic and reason. Miracles are neither chaotic nor causeless events; instead, they are deliberate manifestations displaying the power and conscious will of a Creator.
